ALICE SPRINGS.— The Federal Liberal Leader, Mr John Howard, reaffirmed his party's support for the Territory's statehood bid yesterday at a Centre 200 dinner in Alice Springs.

Mr Howard said the Liberal Party would have sorted out its pol-icy on the details of statehood by August or September next year, but already had no hesi-tation in supporting the basic principle.

"There will of course be some questions about matters such as Senate represen-tation," Mr Howard

"It's very comforting that Mr Howard has seen fit to give a time-table for setting in place a statehood strategy," Mr Hatton said.

Mr Howard also offered a warning to the Federal Government that plans for a compact of understanding with Aborigines could

worsen the alienation of the original inhabitants of Australia.

"We have to be honest enough to recog-nise there is no section of the Australian community which has more proven disadvantage than Aboriginal Aust-ralians," Mr Howard said.

Answer

He said the answer is not to seek refuge in talk of treaties or som-pacts — concepts which are only further divid-ing Australia.

"The most important thing is to locate the areas of disadvantage, and direct policy toward reducing those areas."

Mr Howard, who on Thursday made his first visit to an Aboriginal community, said there was no need for the "self-flagellation" which Australia seemed to give itself over its past at times.
