Although I don't recall meeting you during 1990 when I was door-knocking as the new candidate for Port Darwin, I certainly have a clear recollection of you as one of those Territorians who encouraged and supported me during my time as a Minister and then as Chief Minister.

I believe that I have left behind a legacy that will stand the test of time. Whilst I was not happy about the way in which I left office, the reality was that I was departing in any event.
