## New firm will see justice is served

Alice Springs has hosted a surge of business enterprise in recent weeks and now a Darwin-based law firm has extended its services to ensure that despite the booming population, there is still justice for all.

The firm, Loftus and Cameron, located in Colacag Plaza, officially opens today.

The agency is a family affair, headed by a husband and wife team, solicitors, Shane and Josephine Stone, with Mr Stone's sister, Miss Susan Stone, in charge of reception.

Both husband and wife come from Melbourne; Mr Stone specialised as a barrister in crime and family law and Mrs Stone, in in worker's compensation and personal injury.

### Justice

Mr Stone worked for 18 months as associate to Sir Edward Woodward, former Director General of ASIO and now Justice of the Federal Court.

He spent four years in the Territory on circuit work, representing clients who opt for interstate specialists, before being approached by Loftus and Cameron.

The firm was established by Mr Pat Loftus and the late Mr Peter Cameron in 1980.

Former NT Director of Law, Mr Bill Raby, succeeded Mr Cameron.

Mr Stone said the firm had re-assessed the need to provide a service encompassing the entire Territory and since had opened agencies in Katherine and now Alice Springs.

Mr Stone said: "Other law practices in town have been very receptive towards my wife and I and have been extended every courtesy."
