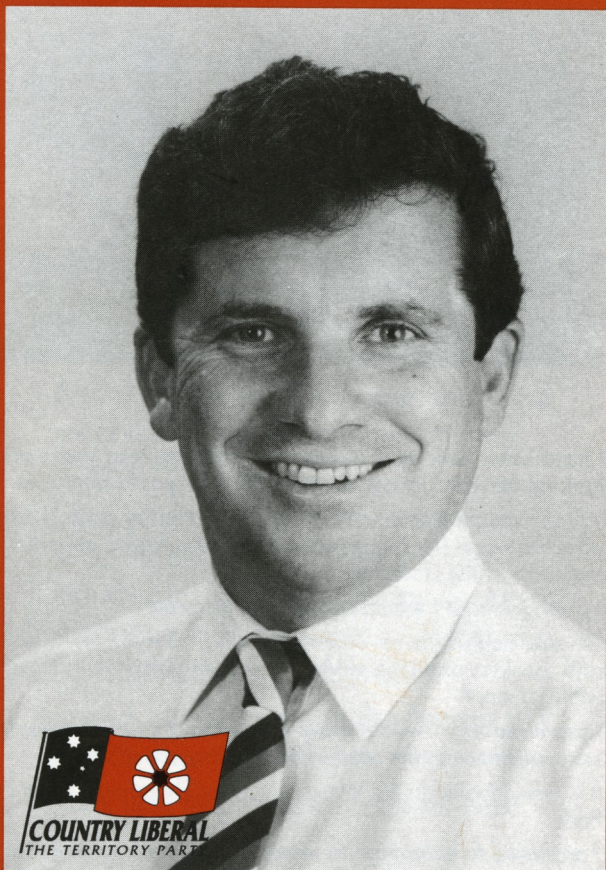

I need *Shane Stone* in the Perron CLP Government's third term team.

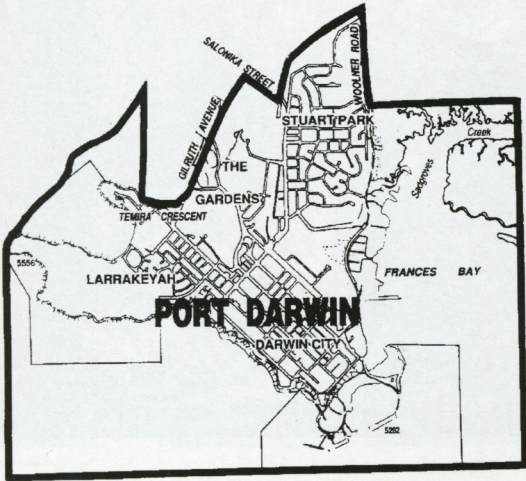
