Two former Federal Presidents of the Liberal Party have recently been honoured with awards in the Order of Australia:

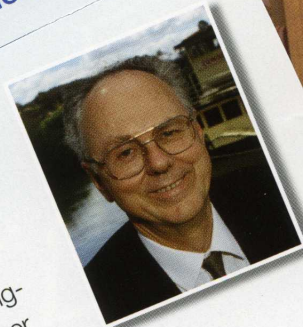
THE HON SHANE L STONE, AC

In the 2006 Queen's Birthday Honours, Shane Stone, former Chief Minister of the Northern Territory and Liberal Party Federal President 1999 – 2005, became a Companion of the Order of Australia. The award recognised "service to politics contributing to strengthening Federal-State-Territory intergovernmental processes, to furthering the bi-lateral relationship between Australia and the Asia-Pacific region, and to the oil and gas industry."

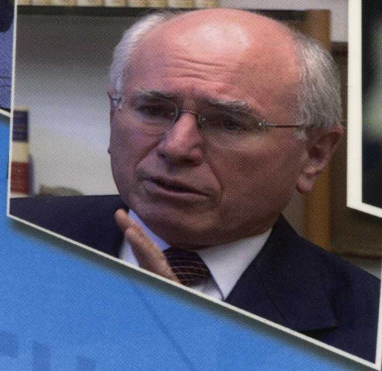
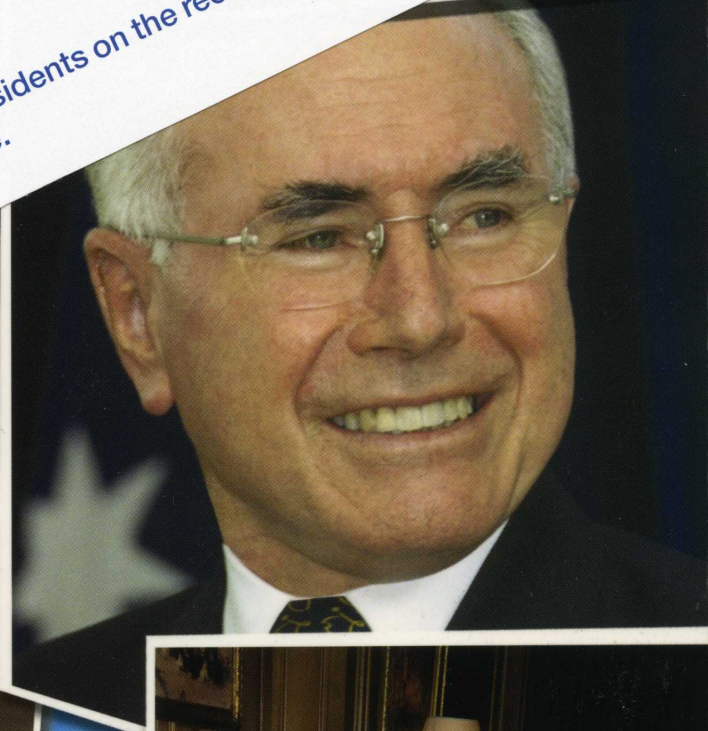


THE HON TONY STALEY, AO

In the 2007 Australia Day Honours, Tony Staley, a long-serving minister in the Fraser Government and Liberal Party Federal President 1993 – 1999, became an Officer of the Order of Australia "for service to politics as a parliamentarian and contributor to the development of the Liberal Party of Australia, to the telecommunications industry, and to the arts."
